

RAILINC | Shipment Conditions File FAQs

What is a Shipment Condition File (SCF) Code?

SCF Codes restrict prices or restrict calculation of total charges: they define price qualification. SCF condition codes can specify anything from equipment types to accessorial services and annual volume agreements on an electronic waybill. SCF Codes are standardized to allow electronic pricing through REN, and as such, are maintained by the SCF Technical Advisory Group. Any changes to SCF codes follow strict change control parameters.

Centralized Station Master (CSM) Codes restrict billing and are maintained within the structure of the SCF database. Changes to these codes are the responsibility of the CSM Technical Advisory Group.

Serving Carrier Reciprocal Switching Codes (SCRS) restrict routing and are also maintained within the structure of the SCF database. Changes to these codes are the responsibility of the SCRS Technical Advisory Group.
